

# Changes are coming to Route 311



We'll Get You There

**Starting Sept. 30**, Route 311 will run only between Seattle and Woodinville. Commute alternatives will still be available between Woodinville and Duvall. These changes are part of a larger revision of transit service in the Snoqualmie Valley, with modifications to several routes and creation of a new Valley Shuttle. Our goal is to enhance mobility for Snoqualmie Valley residents in a way that is more cost effective than fixed-route bus service alone.

## Planning your commute

Current riders of Route 311 between Woodinville and Duvall can reach their destinations using two alternative routes:

### ■ Between Duvall and Redmond or downtown Seattle

Commuter Route 232 and a more frequent all-day Route 224 will connect Duvall and Redmond. From there, the Redmond Transit Center offers frequent, all-day service to and from downtown Seattle on Sound Transit Route 545. See back for routes 224 and 232 schedules to and from Redmond.

### ■ To the Woodinville Park-and-Ride

Routes 232 and 931 will still connect Avondale Road NE and the Woodinville Park-and-Ride. For riders coming from Duvall, Routes 232 and 931 will still connect at NE Woodinville-Duvall Road and Avondale Road NE. Route 311 will keep the same number of trips between the Woodinville Park-and-Ride and downtown Seattle.

## Rideshare Opportunities

Metro offers assistance with vanpools, vanshares, and carpools to connect with the Route 311 in Woodinville. ## More trips, new routes for other service to Duvall

Also starting on Sept. 28, Route 224 will run only between Duvall and Redmond. It will make more trips. The part of Route 224 that connects Duvall and Fall City will be replaced with new, all-day service on the Valley Shuttle operated by Snoqualmie Valley Transportation. This shuttle will also provide flexible routing in Duvall, where riders will be able to call to schedule pick-up times.
