

Notes

1. In the upper watershed, bare ground may show up as an orange or red color ("mining", "industrial" or high/medium density residential").
2. Land cover is based on 1995 satellite imagery, sampling each 30 square meters in King County. The land cover was interpreted by the King County Water and Land Resources' GIS & Visual Communications Unit.
3. Shaded relief is based on USGS digital elevation models with elevation samples spaced 30 meters apart. Shaded relief was developed by the King County Water and Land Resources' Water and Land GIS & Visual Communications Unit.
