In early 2009, King County will unveil the Marymoor Connector Trail, the newest addition to its inventory of over 175 miles of regional trails. This new trail will connect the popular Sammamish River Trail with the Eastlake Sammamish Trail, creating a contiguous regional trail stretching from Issaquah to Seattle.
