NOTICE OF ACTION TAKEN

NOTICE IS GIVEN UNDER SEPA, RCW 43.21c.080, THAT THE KING COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND PARKS TOOK THE ACTION DESCRIBED IN (2) BELOW ON OCTOBER 21, 2014.

- 1. Action Deadline:** Any action to set aside, enjoin, review, or otherwise challenge such action on the grounds of non-compliance with the provisions of chapter 43.21C RCW (State Environmental Policy Act) shall be commenced on or before 4:30 p.m. on November 11, 2014.
- 2. Description of Agency Action:** The King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks made a decision to proceed with the Marymoor Park Concert Stage Roof Replacement (Project #1123527). Following this Notice of Action, the King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks will obtain the required permits and proceed with this project.
- 3. Description of Proposal:** The proposed project will replace the existing temporary fabric concert stage roof, which has outlived its usefulness and is now in need of major structural repairs, with a permanent roof that meets the requirements of artists performing at the venue. The new roof will also offer better protection from the rain and will protect the stage from the weather in the off-season. The roof will be slightly taller but will have a thinner profile and is designed to blend more nicely into the surrounding landscape.

The new roof design will include an acoustical deck, or similar material, that will provide more sound attenuation than the existing roof. In addition the new roof will be stiff and angled to direct the sound toward the audience and ground. This should provide an improvement over noise levels. An acoustical consultant is assigned to the project and is assisting with the technical aspects of keeping sound levels similar or lower than under existing conditions.

The project site is located in the Willowmoor Farm Historic District (a sub-area of Marymoor Park) which includes the Clise Mansion and associated grounds. The project is being reviewed by the King County Landmarks Commission for compatibility with the Historic District. Measures to minimize impacts to the Historic District include: painting the roof a dark color (such as brown or black); keeping the structural supports as small as possible while still being structurally sound; and conducting archeological monitoring in the areas of excavation.

4. **Location of Proposal:** The proposed project is located in King County's Marymoor Park located at 6046 West Lake Sammamish Parkway NE in Redmond, Washington (SW Quadrant of Section 12, Township 25N, Range 5E). The concert stage is located on the west side of the park and can be accessed most readily by entering the park from West Lake Sammamish Parkway NE and following the directional signs.
5. **Type of Environmental Review under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA):** The King County Department of Natural Resource and Parks is the SEPA lead agency for the proposal and reviewed project information, prepared a SEPA Environmental Checklist, and determined that the project does not have probable significant adverse impacts on the environment, which resulted in issuance of a Determination of Non-Significance on September 16, 2014 with a 14-day comment period that ended on September 30, 2014. A SEPA environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 43.21C.030(2)(c).
