
### King County re-opens Burke-Gilman Trail from Ballinger Way NE to Logboom Park

King County continues to make progress redeveloping the Burke-Gilman Trail from Kenmore through Lake Forest Park. The northern segment of the Burke-Gilman Trail from Ballinger Way Northeast to Logboom Park will re-open by Dec. 31. The trail from Northeast 145th Street to Ballinger Way Northeast is expected to remain closed until late January, as crews complete paving work and finalize key safety features, including installing fencing, bollards and intersection treatments. Weather is a significant factor in completing paving work over the next few weeks.

Redeveloping this 30-year-old corridor has presented many challenges. Topography, limited access, poor soil conditions and underground utility conflicts have had an impact on construction. Contractor crews have been working extended hours since September in an effort to complete the project as quickly as possible. We appreciate your continued patience during construction.

#### Construction Detour

The detour will remain in place from Ballinger Way Northeast to Northeast 94th Street until the project is


