- Requirements:**
- Must be 18 years of age or older.
 - Required commitment of an average of 3 hours per concert.
 - Required to be present for entire shift assigned.
 - One clean-up shift is required - new volunteers will do this at their first concert.
 - Expected to arrive at volunteer booth 10 minutes PRIOR to beginning of assigned shift (20 minutes prior to FIRST shift of the season).
 - Must read and sign full Volunteer Expectation sheet at first shift (see attached form).
 - Must sign the volunteer liability waiver form before each shift.

Expectations:

Being friendly and approachable is a must! Crew volunteers teach concert-goers about sorting their recyclable and compostable materials and will assist them in using appropriate bins, as well as help keep the Marymoor concert venue free of litter.

If you have the first shift you must wait until the gates open to "save your spot" in the seating area.

It is expressly prohibited to consume alcohol during or prior to your volunteer shift. Volunteers drinking alcohol during their shift or arriving under the influence for their shift will be asked to leave and can no longer volunteer for future concerts

Concerts are held rain or shine. Dress appropriately for the weather and site conditions.

Volunteers work in a team and are required to do some lifting and pushing of yard carts. Volunteers stand throughout the shift.

King County Parks is not responsible for lost or stolen valuables. Volunteers will be under the same rules as other concert attendees' for restricted items.
