



EXPECTATIONS and AGREEMENT

The "Marymoor Composter/Recycling Crews" assist concert-goers in redirecting more than half of the waste generated at concerts from the landfill and into the compost and recycling stream. Crew volunteers teach concert-goers about their recyclable and compostable materials and assist them in using appropriate bins at the sorting stations. Volunteers will also sort non-trash materials from other bins and help keep the Marymoor concert venue free of litter.

In exchange for your work to safeguard the environment, Recycling Crew volunteers receive free entry and parking to the shows at which they volunteer. Volunteers will be able to watch the show before or after their shift and are able to hear the entire concert. Breaks are allowed, and water and snacks will be provided at the volunteer tent. Food, coffee, and other beverages are available for purchase at the venue.

It is expressly prohibited to consume alcohol during or prior to your volunteer shift. Volunteers drinking alcohol during their shift or arriving under the influence for their shift will be asked to leave and can no longer volunteer for future concerts. Volunteers are expected to be courteous and approachable. Volunteers must be at least 18 years old.

Shift hours vary depending on show times. The first shift usually begins 1½ hours before the concert and includes set-up. The second shift starts half-way thru the concert, goes until the end and includes break-down and about one hour of clean-up afterwards. All duties end by 11:00 p.m. Everyone is expected to stay for at least one clean-up; new volunteers must work the last shift (which includes clean-up) at their first concert. Training will be provided on site.

Concerts are held rain or shine. Volunteers should dress appropriately for the weather. Wear comfortable clothes and shoes appropriate for walking on grassy areas and uneven ground. You will stand during most of the shift and are required to do some lifting and pushing of heavy carts, but will be relieved for regularly scheduled breaks.

King County Parks is not responsible for lost or stolen valuables. Volunteers will be under the same rules as other concert attendees' for restricted items, such as blankets or low-backed chairs. You can leave your personal items in the booth area, but you do so at your own risk.

Thank you for joining the volunteer crew and doing your part to reduce, reuse, and recycle materials that would otherwise be sent to the landfill.
