

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT PUBLIC RULES
AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The Department of Natural Resources and Parks (DNRP) intends to adopt public rules pursuant to authority granted it by King County Code chapter 2.98 and King County Ordinance 16581.

The purpose of these rules is to implement Ordinance 16581 by providing notice to the public of the process DNRP will use to define and document procedures to consider recreational safety issues in the design of projects involving the placement of large wood in King County rivers. The rules also identify the procedures for public review and comment on projects that will utilize large wood elements in the design.

Any interested person may submit **written** comments concerning the proposed public rule. Comments must be received by DNRP, no later than **5:00 p.m., Friday, February 19, 2010**.
