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## **Notice of Action**

### **Cedar Rapids Levee Setback Repair - 2012 Project**

Notice is hereby given under SEPA, RCW 43.21C.080, that the Water and Land Resources Division (WLRD), King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks, Capital Projects Section, took the action described in item 2 below on February 6, 2012.

1. Any action to set aside, enjoin, review, or otherwise challenge such action on the grounds of non-compliance with the provisions of Chapter 43.21C RCW shall be commenced on or before March 8, 2012.
2. The agency decision is to proceed on final design and construction of the Cedar Rapids Levee Setback Repair - 2012 Project.
3. The proposed project is located within the Cedar Rapids Natural Area on the Cedar River between RM 7.2 and 7.4. The levee setback modification along the left bank will occur between RM 7.20 and 7.40, and the revetment setback project on the right bank will occur at RM 7.25. These river locations roughly correspond to the 17600 block of SR-169 (Maple Valley Highway) on the left bank, and SE Jones Road on the right bank.
4. A Determination of Non-Significance was published and opened for review and public comment from December 16, 2011 through January 6, 2012. Project support documentation and project site maps are available for review at WLRD Offices from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays. The offices are located at King Street Center, 201 South Jackson Street, Suite 600, Seattle, Washington 98104. John Engel is the Project Manager and may be contacted at 206-263-0160.
5. A Decision to Proceed was signed on February 6, 2012 by Mark Isaacson, WLRD Division Director. This Notice of Action was filed on February 9, 2012 and will continue in effect through March 8, 2012.
