Please join us to learn about a new coastal flood hazard study, draft flood maps for the marine shoreline of Vashon-Maury Island, and new proposed coastal flood regulations. The updated information will be used to revise federal flood insurance rate maps for property owners within unincorporated King County. Staff from King County's River and Floodplain Management team and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) will be presenting.

A public comment period on the proposed regulations will begin mid April 2011 and public comments on the draft flood maps will be accepted until May 13, 2011.
