Decision to Proceed

The Parks Division of King County's Department of Natural Resources and Parks (DNRP) has made a Decision to Proceed with the Agency Action, as described below.

Proposal Name

Forest Practices (non-conversion Class 4G) on King County Parks land.

Proposal Description

This multi-project proposal covers all forest practices on King County Parks lands permitted as Class 4G non-conversion actions by King County DDES. These activities are classified as "Class 4G" under the Forest Practices Act because they are occurring on parcels platted after 1960 (requiring SEPA and review by the local permit agency); "non-conversion" means the land will remain in long-term forest/open space use. King County DNRP is analyzing these similar, non-conversion forest practices in a single checklist, as allowed in WAC 197-11-060(3)(c), and is addressing them together in this determination. The intention is to have this multi-project SEPA process cover applications for Class 4G non-conversion forest practices in 2011 and future years.

Agency Action

The Parks and Recreation Division Director hereby approves the above-described Determination of Non-Significance Project Proposal for Forest Practices. The Parks and Recreation Division fully complied with the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) Rules regarding notification, and SEPA documents for this proposal as required under WAC 197-11, RCW 43.21c, Ordinance 12196, and ESHB 1724.
