Following is a summary of the changes to the “Stormwater Pollution Prevention Manual, Best Management Practices for Businesses”.

1. These changes were made to reach equivalency with the Department of Ecology’s Manual.

- Chapter 3, “Stormwater Best Management Practices for Specific Activities”, has been updated. The following Activity Sheets have been changed:
 - A-16 Truck or Rail Loading or Unloading of Liquid or Solid Material
 - A-18 Vehicle and Equipment Repair and Maintenance
 - A-26 Landscaping Activities and Vegetation Management

The following new Activity Sheets have been added:

- A-44 Dust Control and Soil Erosion and Sediment Control for Manufacturing and Other Commercial Operations
- A-45 Maintenance of Public and Private Utility Corridors and Facilities

- Chapter 4, “Residential Best Management Practices”, has been revised such that the residential best management practices are required for single family residential activities instead of recommended.
- Chapter 6, “Technical Assistance”, was changed to include a section called “Activities that May Result in Prohibited Discharges”, the crosswalk to the King County Code.

2. The following had minor changes.

- Table 2.1, “Potential Pollutants and Impacts Associated with Activities”, received edits.
- Chapter 3, “Stormwater Best Management Practices for Specific Activities”, has been edited. The following Activity Sheets have had minor changes: A-1, A-2, A-3, A-4, A-5, A-8, A-9, A-11, A-13.
- Activity Sheet R-1 in Chapter 4, “Residential Best Management Practices”, has been revised.
