The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) has reviewed the revised draft Scope of Work, dated November 2015, for watershed-scale stormwater planning in the Bear Creek Watershed. This project is a collaboration between King County, Snohomish County, the City of Redmond and the City of Woodinville. King County submitted the Scope of Work for Ecology's review and approval on behalf of Snohomish County and the cities of Redmond and Woodinville. The Scope of Work is in accordance with the 2013-2018 Phase I Municipal Stormwater National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit (Phase I Permit), Special Condition S5.C.5.c.iv, applicable to King County and Snohomish County, and the 2013-2018 Phase II Western Washington Municipal Stormwater Permit, Special Condition S5.C.4.g.ii.

Ecology approves the November 2015 scope of work.

Ecology looks forward to working with the project team as this watershed-scale stormwater planning project in the Bear Creek Watershed is implemented.
