The Challenge: King County has responsibilities for implementation of salmon recovery, reduction of flood risks and maintaining the viability of farming. Some of the actions that are needed to meet these diverse objectives overlap on the ground. So, at the scale of individual farms or parcels and valley-wide, it is often challenging to find the right balance when undertaking actions to support any one of these priorities.
