

## **Knotweed Biology and Control Workshops**

This workshop will teach about invasive knotweed species including Japanese, Bohemian, Giant and Himalayan Knotweed. Topics to be covered in the first part include identification, biology, reproduction, distribution and impacts. The second part of the workshop will cover control methods that are effective (and some not so effective) in controlling the different species of knotweed, including manual, mechanical, cultural, biological and chemical control. Included in the chemical control section, we will give comprehensive instructions on the use and care of knotweed injection guns. Individuals completing this workshop will be eligible to borrow the weed program's knotweed injectors.

This workshop is being held on the same days as our annual noxious weed control seminar. If you would like to attend both the seminar and the knotweed workshop, please register for each individually.
