NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Tuesday, March 10, 2009, in King County, State of Washington, there will be held special elections conducted entirely by mail for the purpose of submitting to the voters for their approval or rejection the ballot measures as listed.

Vashon Island School District No. 402
Proposition No. 1
General Obligation Bonds - \$75,550,000
The Board of Directors of Vashon Island School District No. 402 adopted Resolution No. 611 concerning this proposition for bonds. This proposition authorizes the District to construct a new High School classroom building, renovate other buildings, install synthetic turf and a new track, construct a secondary gym, upgrade ventilation and technology systems at McMurray Middle and Chautauqua Elementary Schools, and make other capital improvements, issue \$75,550,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of 20 years, and levy excess property taxes annually to repay the bonds, as described in detail in Resolution No. 611. Auburn School District No. 408
Proposition No. 1
Bonds for Replacement of Aging Schools - \$239,000,000

The Board of Directors of Auburn School District No. 408 approved a proposition for bonds. This proposition authorizes the District to plan, construct and equip the replacements of Auburn High School, Olympic Middle School and Terminal Park Elementary School and make other capital improvements, to issue \$239,000,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of 20 years, and levy excess property taxes annually to repay the bonds, as described in Resolution No. 1102. Snoqualmie Valley School District No. 410
Proposition No. 1
General Obligation Bonds - \$27,480,000

The Board of Directors of Snoqualmie Valley School District No. 410 approved a proposition for bonds. To alleviate overcrowding, the proposition authorizes the District to acquire portables at Mount Si High School to provide temporary capacity, upgrade existing school facilities, rebuild tennis courts displaced by portables at Mount Si High School and make other capital improvements; to issue \$27,480,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of 20 years, and levy excess property taxes annually to repay the bonds, as described in Resolution No. 727.
