

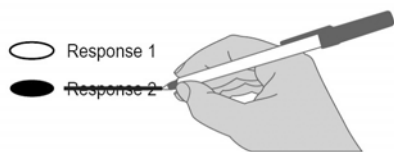

#### Renton School District No. 403 Proposition No. 1 Replacement Educational Maintenance and Operations Levy

The Board of Directors adopted Resolution No. 05-11/12 concerning educational funding. This proposition authorizes the District to levy the following excess taxes, to replace an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, to support the District's educational maintenance and operations:

Collection Years	Approximate Levy Rate/\$1,000 Assessed Value	Levy Amount
2013	\$2.66	\$38,100,000
2014	\$2.78	\$39,800,000
2015	\$2.88	\$41,600,000
2016	\$2.98	\$43,500,000

#### Renton School District No. 403 Proposition No. 2 Building for a Lifetime of Learning School Building Improvement Bonds - \$97,000,000

The Board of Directors of Renton School District No. 403 approved a proposition for bonds. The proposition authorizes the District to construct a new middle school; renovate the Lindbergh pool; remodel, upgrade and improve existing school facilities, fields and play areas; improve energy conservation; acquire additional property and make other capital improvements; to issue \$97,000,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of 20 years, and levy excess property taxes annually to repay the bonds, as described in Resolution No. 06-11/12. Technology Capital Projects Levy**

The Board of Directors of Renton School District No. 403 adopted Resolution No. 07-11/12 concerning a technology modernization levy. The proposition authorizes the modernization of District facilities by implementing technology facilities and projects and the application and modernization of technology systems for operations and instruction; and authorizes the following excess levies for such purposes on all taxable property within the District:
