



West Seattle Ferry Named after Seahawk Kicker Steven Hauschka, Running All Day for Super Bowl Parade

SEATTLE – As Seattle prepares for the biggest party it has ever thrown, attendees will have an extra way to get to the celebration. The King County Ferry District will run passenger only ferry service and shuttles all day from West Seattle to Downtown.

Celebrants can cross Puget Sound on the “MV Steven Hauschka Ferry” – answering calls heard by King County Ferry District Chair Joe McDermott that “*Hauschka needs a boat!*” McDermott has directed the vessels be named in honor of the awesome Seahawk kicker who scored the Seahawks’ first offensive points.

“Last week Washington State Ferries renamed their ferries for other Seahawk players. We agree with other 12th men and women that Hauschka deserves a boat named after him. Everyone jump aboard the Hauskchka boat and come to the party,” said McDermott.

The honorary name change will be in effect all day February 5th, 2014.

“We are happy to offer this extended service to 12th men and women coming downtown to celebrate our world championship,” says McDermott.
