The NE 195th Street Bridge is a critical link that connects the North Creek Business Parks to I-405 as well as to downtown Bothell. It is one of the primary access points for the business parks and has an average daily traffic volume close to 20,000.

The original bridge was built in 1949 with widening occurring in 1967 and 1984. While the overall condition rating is relatively high, the age of the original bridge and the type of detailing used drives the need to replace this bridge within a 10-year period. The City will be investigating the original bridge in the next few years to confirm the condition and detailing incorporated.

This bridge is the primary access point to the North Creek Business Parks to I-405. If this bridge were to be closed, it would seriously affect the commute to these business parks and access to freight and customers. It would hurt this local center's economic viability and would overburden other areas of the transportation system as drivers sought other routes into and out of the area. Travel times would increase dramatically.

The project would replace the existing bridge with a new one consisting of 5 vehicular lanes, bicycle lanes, and sidewalks. It would be longer to meet the current hydraulic and environmental requirements.
