This is a preservation project on the significant arterial streets in Shoreline that are in need of significant surface upgrades, ADA and ramp improvements, and new channelization. All but one of these street re-surfacing projects will involve the installation of bicycle lanes in accordance with our Transportation Master Plan bicycle systems plan. Together, these streets carry over 80,000 ADT, and have 40 lane miles of roadway. The projects will include 198 curb ramps, and 186 ramps with truncated domes only. These are principal or minor arterial streets that carry transit, bikes, trucks and vehicles.

Project Status & Timeline

The corridors have been scoped and designed. Cost estimates have been developed. The projects are construction ready.

What is the timeline for this project from start to completion?

The proposal is to do two corridors per biennium starting in 2011/13, and ending in 2015/16.
