Project Description

This project would complete the existing interchange on SR 522 at NE 195th Street. When this existing interchange was designed and constructed in the 1980's, the City of Woodinville was not incorporated and it was assumed that there would be little change from the existing land use, at the time a mixture of suburban housing (one acre lots), rural, and some light industrial. Even though WSDOT policy at the time called construction of interchanges serving all traffic movements, it was decided to construct only the eastbound off ramp and the westbound on ramp as a cost savings measure. The purpose of this project is to construct the eastbound on ramp and the westbound off ramp, completing the interchange. This would stop the diversion of trips to other interchanges that create unusual traffic patterns and congestion in the area, allowing them to function at a higher level of service and provide for more direct access to the state highway system to resident in the east part of Woodinville, and rural northeast King County. The interchange could be reconstructed to a single point interchange configuration to minimize its footprint and improve operation and coordination with other adjoining intersections. This interchange is the connection point of Woodinville-Duvall Road, the dominant east-west arterial in NE King County, to the State freeway system. SR 522 is designated as a highway of statewide significance.
