

OPTIONAL SERVICES DESCRIPTIONS

SMS Forwarding: Enables forwarding of messages sent to the pager to be copied to any SMS device. Important to note that Cook Paging uses **SMS** technology to send the messages to the cellular device, not SMTP (email) protocol as other paging companies. The original message is received in the paging terminal, then dispatched via SMS modems directly to the cellular carriers for broadcast to the SMS devices.

Resend Alpha Page: Enables the end-user to retransmit the last 15 messages sent to an alpha pager, on demand. The end-user dials the pager number, enters a passcode, then directs the system to retransmit the last 4 messages sent to the pager. If further messages are needed, the end-user can direct these to be resent one-at-a-time. The original time & date stamp is displayed for each message, to avoid any confusion about whether this is a "new" or "retransmitted" message. This is an especially useful tool in case the end-user turns off the pager, or the battery dies, or in case the pager is carried into an underground location where no paging signal exists.
