Pursuant to chapter 39.34 RCW and to other provisions of law, the KING COUNTY and the following named municipal corporation, political subdivision, or other public agency of the State of Washington; CITY OF EVERETT hereby agree to cooperative governmental purchasing of TWO (2) FORD 35000# CAB AND CHASSIS (BID #233-90APK) upon the following terms and conditions.

- (1) KING COUNTY, in contracting for the purchase of goods for the COUNTY agrees to extend said supply contracts to other political subdivisions to the extent permitted by law, and agreed upon by the parties.
- (2) The political subdivision accepts responsibility for compliance with any additional or varying laws and regulations governing purchases by or on behalf of the political subdivision in question.
- (3) KING COUNTY accepts no responsibility for the performance of any purchasing contract by the vendor and accepts no responsibility for payment of the purchase price by the political subdivision.

King County therefore extends the use of its contracts to the City of Everett to the extent provided by law and upon the following terms:


- (1) The vendor(s) agree to extend to the City of Everett the terms and conditions of King County's contract(s).


