

Cooperative Purchasing Agreement

In accordance with Chapter 39.34 RCW, King County, King County Fire District #2 and King County Fire District #26 agree to a cooperative governmental purchasing agreement for various equipment and supplies using King County's competitively awarded contracts.

King County therefore extends the use of its contracts to King County Fire District #2 and King County Fire District #26 to the extent provided by law and upon the following terms:

- (1.) The Vendor(s) agree to extend to King County Fire District #2, and King County Fire District #26 the terms and conditions of King County's contract(s).
- (2.) King County Fire District #2, and King County Fire District #26 accept responsibility for compliance with any additional or varying laws and regulations governing its purchases. Any purchases by King County Fire District #2, or King County Fire District #26 shall be effected by a purchase order from King County District #2, or King County Fire District #26 and directed to the vendor.
- (3.) King County accepts no responsibility for the performance of any of the purchasing contracts by the vendor.
- (4.) King County accepts no responsibility for payment of the purchase price by King County Fire District #2 or King County Fire District #26.

This agreement may be revoked at any time in writing by either party.
