## Cooperative Purchasing Agreement

In accordance with King County Code 4.16.110, King County and King County Fire District #43 agrees to a cooperative governmental purchasing agreement for various medical supplies and equipment using King County's competitively awarded contract.

King County therefore extends the use of its contract to King County Fire District #43 to the extent provided by the law and upon the following terms:

- (1) Whereas the vendor has agreed to extend to King County Fire District #43 the terms and conditions of King County's contract which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- (2) King County Fire District #43 accepts the terms and conditions of King County's contract with the vendor.
- (3) King County Fire District #43 accepts responsibility for compliance with any additional or varying laws and regulations governing its purchases. Any purchase by King County Fire District #43 shall be effected by a purchase order from King County Fire District #43 and directed to the vendor.
- (4) King County accepts no responsibility for the performance of any of the purchasing contracts by the vendor.
- (5) King County accepts no responsibility for payment of the purchase price by King County Fire District #43.

This agreement may be revoked at any time in writing by either party.
