In accordance with Chapter 39.34 RCW, King County and South Sound 911 agree to a cooperative governmental purchasing agreement for various equipment and supplies using King County's competitively awarded contracts.

King County therefore extends the use of its contracts to South Sound 911 to the extent provided by law and upon the following terms:

- (1) The vendor(s) agree to extend to South Sound 911 the terms and conditions of King County's contract(s).
- (2) South Sound 911 accepts responsibility for compliance with any additional or varying laws and regulations governing its purchases. Any purchases by South Sound 911 shall be effected by a purchase order from South Sound 911 and directed to the vendor.
- (3) King County accepts no responsibility for the performance of any of the purchasing contracts by the vendor.
- (4) King County accepts no responsibility for payment of the purchase price by South Sound 911.


This agreement may be revoked at any time in writing by either party.
