ACCEPTABLE

Mixed paper:

All office paper grades
(except confidential documents)

Telephone books and
paperback books

File folders, dividers,
and hanging files
(remove metal wire)

Envelopes - with and
without windows

Ream wrappers

Magazines, newspapers,
and hardbound books
(remove covers)

Shredded paper
(bagged separately)



NCR-carbonless forms

Cardboard (flattened
and placed next to
recycling containers)

Plastic bags, plastic
wrap, pallet wrap
(bagged separately)

Mixed containers: (must be clean)

Yogurt containers

Aluminum cans

Tin and steel cans

Plastic bottles and
plastic milk jugs

Glass bottles (must be
clean, not broken)



NOT ACCEPTABLE

Carbon paper,
fluorescent colored paper,
or adhesive label backing

Hardbound books
with covers attached

Plastic or styrofoam
food containers
(except for yogurt containers)

Scrap metal or pallets

Styrofoam or
packing peanuts

Food waste and
wet or soiled paper



Wax coated paper or
kitchen plastic wrap

Paper towels or napkins

Glass - window, mirrors,
or drinking glasses

Ceramics - dishes,
cups, flower pots, etc.
