2. Take I-405 North (Renton / Bellevue) via Exit 154
3. Take WA -181 South /W. Valley Hwy via Exit 1 (Tukwila)
4. Turn left on W. Valley Hwy/WA-181/Interurban Ave. S.
5. Take first right onto SW Grady Way
6. Turn left onto Oakesdale Ave SW
7. Take the first right onto SW 7th St.
8. 1 Green Planet is on the left

2. Take Exit 163, (W. Seattle Bridge, Columbian Way)
3. Take W. Seattle Bridge/Spokane St. ramp toward Safeco Field/Qwest Field
4. Turn right on 4th Ave. South
5. Turn left on S. Forest St.
6. Turn right on 3rd Ave. South
7. Allied Waste facility is on the left
8. Bins are on SW corner of 3rd Ave. S. & S. Lander St.

4. Turn right onto 6th Ave. N.

Accepted at no fee: cardboard (flattened), newspaper, mixed paper, aluminum cans, tin cans, plastic bottles, jars, tubs & jugs. **No glass. Accepts appliances:** refrigerant appliances: \$35. Other appliances: microwaves, ovens, water heaters, dishwashers and stoves - no charge.

1. Turn left onto Orillia Rd; which becomes S. 212th St.
2. Turn right onto 68th Ave. S / W Valley Hwy/ WA-181
3. Turn left onto WA-516/ S Kent Des Moines Rd
4. Take WA-167 S toward Auburn.
5. Take the exit toward Algona/ Pacific
6. Turn right onto Ellingson Rd
7. Turn left onto W Valley Hwy S.
8. Valley Recycling about ½ mile ahead

4. Take the S. 128th St. exit
5. Turn left on S. 128th St.
6. Turn right on 1st Ave. S.
7. 1st Ave. S. becomes Meyers Way (bear right)
8. Store is on the right

Planned improvements to the Bow Lake transfer station:

- An expanded recycling collection area, including a separate yard waste area
- A new transfer building with larger, easier-to-use waste unloading areas, which will reduce customer wait times
- A new site layout that will improve on-site traffic flow
- Improved waste compaction that will improve operational efficiency and reduce the number of transfer trailer trucks that enter and leave the station
- Sustainable building design features that will improve energy efficiency and result in lower life cycle costs than in a conventional building design
- Environmental enhancements to the stormwater and wastewater systems
