

## Secure your load

### What is a secured load?

A secured load of solid waste has been securely fastened, covered, or both in a manner that will prevent the covering or any part of the load from becoming loose, detached or leaving the vehicle while the vehicle is moving except sand may be dropped for the purpose of securing traction.

At King County facilities, unsecured loads will be assessed a \$25 fee per *King County Code 10.12.040*.

## It's the Law!

## Item size limits

- No item longer than 8 feet
- No dense item (larger than 2'x2'x2' and weighing more than 200 pounds, such as concrete blocks and metal safes)

## Vehicle length limits

Maximum combined length limit for vehicles and trailers from bumper to bumper:

- 30 feet at Algona, Cedar Falls, Houghton, Renton, and Vashon stations
- 40 feet at Bow Lake, Enumclaw, Factoria, and Shoreline stations

## Fees – Effective January 1, 2017

### Garbage

- Minimum fee: \$24.25 per entry all vehicles. Covers up to 320 lbs. (includes basic fee, surcharge, and tax)
- Per ton fee: \$144.34 (includes basic fee, surcharge, and tax)

**Note:** Sedans pay only the minimum fee. All other vehicles will be weighed in and out, and charged for the actual weight disposed based on the per ton fee, with a minimum fee of \$24.25.

### Recycling

#### Appliances (major)

- Refrigerant type: \$30 each
- Non-refrigerant type: \$10 each

#### Yard waste and wood (untreated)

- Minimum fee: \$12
- Per ton fee: \$75

#### Unsecured load

- \$25 - strictly enforced

- VISA or MasterCard (credit/debit)
- Cash
- Checks — payable to "KCSWD"
- Solid waste disposal cards (Skykomish only)

<a href="#">Dead animals</a> up to 15 pounds												Garbage fee	Larger than 15 pounds requires waste clearance **
<a href="#">Dirt</a> - uncontaminated												Garbage fee	Contaminated dirt requires waste clearance ** Will accept clean soil if less than one pickup truck load.

<a href="#">Fluorescent lights and other mercury-containing bulbs and tubes</a>												No fee	To recycle: Limit of 10 bulbs/tubes per person per day. Broken bulbs must be sealed in a bag or box. <a href="#">Lawnmowers</a>												No fee to recycle	Remove any fluids.
<a href="#">Mattresses and box springs</a>												Garbage fee	Limit 6 per customer, per day. More than 6 requires a waste clearance. **
<a href="#">Metal – scrap</a> (BBQ grills, plumbing parts, lawnmowers, chain link fencing, etc.)												No fee to recycle	To recycle: Must be at least 50% metal. No paint cans, drums, or pressurized containers. Remove any fluids.
<b>Motor vehicles and major parts</b>	<b>NOT ACCEPTED</b>											Contact auto wrecking yards for recycling options	
<a href="#">Packing peanuts</a>												Garbage fee	Must be bagged and securely tied
<a href="#">Paint – latex</a>												Garbage fee	No liquid – must be solidified or dried out
<a href="#">Paint – oil based</a>												No fee	Accepted at Factoria HHW only. No containers larger than 5 gallons. Households limited to 50 gallons a day. Commercial loads visit <a href="http://lhwp.org">lhwp.org</a>
<a href="#">Paper *</a>												No fee to recycle	To recycle: Food boxes must be empty. No food-soiled paper. Bag and tie shredded paper in clear plastic bag.
<a href="#">Plastic containers</a> (bottles, cups, jugs, tubs, etc.) *												No fee to recycle	To recycle: Must be empty. No toxic product containers. Lids over 3" and labels OK.
<a href="#">Printers, fax machines, scanners</a>												Garbage fee	For recycling options visit <a href="http://kingcounty.gov/takeitback">kingcounty.gov/takeitback</a>
<a href="#">Propane tanks and pressurized containers</a>												No fee	Accepted at Factoria HHW only. Tank must be empty. 8 gallon limit.
<a href="#">Sharps – home-generated only</a> (needles, syringes, etc.)												No fee	Accepted in designated bin. Must be in a puncture resistant, leak proof container with a tight fitting lid. Visit <a href="http://kingcounty.gov/WhatDoDoWith">kingcounty.gov/WhatDoDoWith</a> for more info. Sharps disposal at Vashon requires a waste clearance. **
<b>Televisions</b>	<b>NOT ACCEPTED</b>											Contact 1-800-732-9253, <a href="http://ecyclewashington.org">ecyclewashington.org</a> for free recycling options	
<a href="#">Textiles</a> (clothing, fabric, shoes, curtains, linens, pillows, stuffed animals, throw rugs, etc.)"												No fee to recycle	To recycle: Reusable and torn, worn, stained items accepted. Single shoes OK. No carpet or items that are wet, mildewed or soiled with hazardous materials.
<a href="#">Thermometers / thermostats</a>												No fee	Accepted at Factoria HHW only. Visit <a href="http://kingcounty.gov/WhatDoDoWith">kingcounty.gov/WhatDoDoWith</a> for more options.
<a href="#">Tires</a>												Garbage fee	Limit 4 per customer. No large truck tires.
<a href="#">Wood – treated, painted, stained</a> (railroad ties, etc.)												Garbage fee	No dump trucks or dump trailers. No items longer than 8 feet.
<a href="#">Wood – untreated, unpainted, unstained</a> (crates, lumber, pallets, plywood)												Reduced fee if recycled	To recycle: No branches, sod, soil, or rocks. No metal hinges or latches. No items longer than 8 feet. Mixed loads of garbage and wood will be charged the garbage fee.
<a href="#">Yard waste</a> (branches, brush, grass, leaves, etc.)												Reduced fee if recycled	To recycle: No sod, soil, rocks, or plastic bags. No items longer than 8 feet. Mixed loads of garbage and yard waste will be charged the garbage fee.

\* Place these materials together in "Recyclable Materials" bin. \*\* May be accepted at Cedar Hills Regional Landfill with prior approval known as a "waste clearance." Fees apply. Call 206-477-4466.
