

Accepted for disposal at all facilities

- **Appliances (small)** such as microwaves and toasters.
- **Batteries** – alkaline batteries such as AA, AAA, C, D, & 9-volt.
- **Latex paint that is dried out or solidified.**
- **Printers, fax machines and scanners.**
- **Polystyrene packing material (“peanuts”)** – must be bagged securely to prevent litter.
- **Truck canopies** – shell type only.
No campers.
- **Used oil filters** – must be drained for 24 hours or crushed.
- **Yard waste** – accepted as garbage at all stations. Accepted for recycling at Cedar Falls, Enumclaw & Shoreline stations if separated from garbage.

Reuse or recycle your unwanted items when possible.

Maximum combined length limit for vehicles and trailers (Subject to operating conditions)

Total length from bumper to bumper may not exceed:

- 30 feet** at Algona, Cedar Falls, Factoria, Houghton, Renton, and Vashon
- 40 feet** at Bow Lake, Enumclaw, and Shoreline

- No smoking
- Watch for moving vehicles
- Use extreme caution
- Follow directions from staff

Recycling Services at King County Solid Waste Facilities

Restrictions

****Appliances (large) - \$24 refrigerant type, \$10 other large appliance**
Includes appliances that contain or contained refrigerants (refrigerators, freezers, etc) and other large appliances (water heaters, stoves, dishwashers, etc).

Limit 3 per load
Appliances must be empty
No commercial appliances

Basic Recyclables - no charge (See scrap metal for more info)
• Aluminum cans and tin cans • Cardboard
• Glass bottles and jars • Newspapers
• Mixed paper – includes catalogs, junk mail, magazines, phone books, hard and soft cover books, dry food boxes (remove liners), frozen and refrigerated food boxes, cardboard milk and juice cartons, shredded paper in paper bags.
• Plastic bottles, jars, tubs, and jugs – includes shampoo, juice, and soda bottles, milk and laundry jugs, margarine tubs and other dairy tubs.

Rinse all containers and flatten boxes.

No scrap metal, aerosol or paint cans, wood wrappers, plastic bags, food-soiled paper, bottle caps or lids, bulbs, mirrors, ceramics or windowpanes.

No styrofoam, packaging peanuts, food trays, clamshell containers or any plastic container that held motor oil, pesticides, or any hazardous product.

****Batteries** (Rechargeable and "button" batteries) - **no charge**

****Batteries (vehicle or marine) - no charge**

Limit 5 per customer per day

CD, DVD and VCR players - \$5.00 per item

Limit 10 per load

Clean wood - \$82.50 per ton/\$13.25 minimum fee per entry
Includes plywood, construction lumber, oriented strand board (OSB), pallets, lath (no plaster), wood shingles, stumps, and branches.

Items must be less than 8 ft long
No painted, stained or treated wood
Clean wood must be separated from garbage

****Fluorescent light bulbs and tubes – Factoria HHW Service: no charge Shoreline: \$0.80 per bulb/tube**

Limit 10 per load (Factoria HHW Service)
Limit 12 per load (Shoreline station)

****Mercury-containing items- no charge** Includes high intensity discharge bulbs and tubes, thermometers and thermostats.

****Propane Tanks** (8 gallon max.)

Reusable household goods Includes small furniture (no couches), kitchenware, tools, office and household furnishings (no mattresses), toys, books & videos

Items must be in good condition, suitable for resale

Scrap metal - no charge (Including aluminum cans and tin cans)

Textiles - no charge Includes reusable clothing, fabric curtains, linens, area rugs, boots & shoes

Yard waste - \$82.50 per ton/\$13.25 minimum fee per entry
Includes compostable items – grass, leaves, brush, weeds, Christmas trees, branches. (OK to put food scraps & food-soiled paper, such as pizza boxes, in with yard waste at Shoreline station only)

No dirt or sod
Items must be less than 8 ft long
Yard waste must be separated from garbage
No meat or dairy food scraps

Disposal Restrictions at King County Solid Waste Facilities

King County's solid waste facilities are designed to accept a wide range of materials. However, there are legal, operational and safety reasons why some materials are restricted.

Accepted for disposal with restrictions

Accepted from residential self-haul customers only

- **Containerized sharps** - home generated only. Accepted in designated sharps bin at Shoreline station.
- **Dirt (uncontaminated)** - up to one pickup truck full. Must control dust.
- **Drums** - limit one open, empty metal or plastic drum per load.
- **Tires** - passenger car tires only. Limit 4 per load.
- **Treated wood** - such as railroad ties, pressure treated wood. Must be less than 8 feet long.

Accepted from residential self-haul and commercial customers

- **Construction and demolition debris** - not accepted from dump trucks, flat beds that dump, or roll-off boxes. (Dump trucks, flat beds and roll-offs accepted at the Vashon station only.) No items longer than 8 ft. Vehicle & trailer length limits apply.
- **Hot tubs** - accepted at Bow Lake, Enumclaw, and Vashon stations only. Must meet size and length limits.
- **Mattresses or box springs** - combined total of 6 per customer/company per day.

WHAT SHOULD YOU DO WITH A WORN OR TORN U.S. FLAG?

- Contact your local Veterans of Foreign Wars Post at **1-816-756-3390** or **www.vfw.org** about proper disposal.
- Flags are collected at the Shoreline station - ask staff for information.

Not accepted for disposal, but accepted for recycling at facilities noted

- **Appliances (large)** - includes refrigerators, hot water heaters, dishwashers, etc. (Enumclaw, Shoreline, Vashon)
- **Batteries** - rechargeable, button batteries, vehicle and marine (Factoria HHW only)
- **Fluorescent light bulbs & tubes** (Factoria HHW & Shoreline)
- **Household hazardous waste (HHW)** - includes automotive fluids, oil-based paints, pesticides, wood preservatives, and petroleum products (Factoria HHW only)
- **Mercury-containing items** - includes high-intensity discharge bulbs and tubes, thermometers and thermostats (Factoria HHW only)
- **Propane tanks** (Factoria HHW only)

Not accepted for disposal at transfer stations

- **Items more than 8 feet long** - includes large objects such as boats, trailers and campers.
- **Explosives** including fireworks and ammunition.
- **Burning or smoldering material.**
- **Computers and monitors.**
- **Dense items** - items that are bigger than 2 ft x 2 ft x 2 ft and weigh more than 200 lbs. Examples include big pieces of concrete, large stumps and wood stoves.

- **Hazardous or dangerous waste.**
- **Liquids.**
- **Motor vehicles and major vehicle parts.**
- **Paint** - no liquid latex or oil-based paint (dried out or solidified latex paint is okay).

These items need prior written approval for disposal

Contact King County Solid Waste Division about "waste clearance" at 206-296-4466. Disposal locations limited. Special waste fees may apply.

- **Items more than 8 feet long** - includes large objects such as boats, trailers, and campers.
- **Asbestos-containing materials** - Contact Puget Sound Clean Air Agency (206-343-8800 or www.pscleanair.org) for removal, packaging and transportation information.
- **Contaminated soil.**
- **Dead animals** - over 15 pounds.
- **Dense items** - items that are bigger than 2 ft x 2 ft x 2 ft and weigh more than 200 lbs. Examples include big pieces of concrete, large stumps and wood stoves.
- **Excessively dusty or odorous wastes.**
- **Home heating oil tanks** or other underground storage tanks.
- **Industrial waste products.**
- **Lengths of cable, wire, stranded wire rope, etc.**
- **Metal or plastic drums** - in quantities greater than one.
- **Needles and other sharps** from clinics, hospitals, dentists, etc.

Fees

GARBAGE: New Fees Effective Jan. 1, 2012

Minimum fee: \$20.00 per entry all vehicles. Covers up to 320 lbs. (includes basic fee, surcharge & tax)

Per ton fee: \$117.82 (Includes basic fee, surcharge & tax)

Note: Sedans pay only the minimum fee. All other vehicles will be weighed in and out, and charged for the actual weight disposed based on the per ton fee, with a minimum fee of \$20.00
