Acceptable Recyclable Materials

We unload recyclables in the following order. For more information, please call (425) 430-7398.

ACCEPTED ITEMS

1. Plastics

- **#2 HDPE and #4 LDPE plastic bags only.**
Remove receipts and food debris.
- **Styrofoam peanuts and bubble wrap-**
Foam “peanuts” and “popcorn” only,
- **NO hard or molded plastics (i.e. swimming pools, buckets, flower pots, detergent buckets, etc.)**
- **NO hard Styrofoam packaging.**

2. Reusable household goods

- Clothing, small furniture, small appliances and household items that are in good condition and reusable “as is.”
- **NO console TVs, sofas, baby furniture, broken furniture, appliances, mattresses, hide-a-beds or water beds.**

3. Unusable textiles

- Stained, torn or otherwise unusable clothing, sheets, towels and other fabric items accepted.
Separate from reusable items.
- **NO wet material or furniture cushions**

4. “Ni-Cad” batteries & cell phones

- Battery label will state “Ni-cd” or “Nickel Cadmium.”
These are rechargeable batteries typically used in cellular phones, cordless power tools, laptop computers and camcorders.
- **NO alkaline batteries accepted.**

5. Lead-acid batteries

- Car, truck, marine and motorcycle batteries accepted.
- Residential waste only.
- **NO household batteries.**

6. Uncontaminated antifreeze

- Store in sealed, lidded, reusable container.
- Do not mix with any other substances.
- Residential waste only.

7. Uncontaminated motor oil

- Store in sealed, lidded, reusable container.
- Do not mix with any other substances.
- Residential waste only.

8. Used oil filters

- All automobile filters accepted. Residential waste only.

9. Car, pickup truck and motorcycle tires

- Bias ply, steel belted and studded tires accepted.
Instructions:
- Take tires off rims
 - Residential waste only
 - Limit 10 tires per load
 - Call 425-430-7396 for approval or larger loads
 - **NO semi truck tires. No tractor tires.**

10. Refrigerators & freezers - \$25 cash only

- There will be a \$25.00 cash only charge per unit.
- **NO air conditioners or commercial refrigeration equipment.**

11. Scrap metal and appliances

- Auto parts, lawn chairs, water heaters, lawn movers, bikes, iron and steel.

Instructions:

- All nonmetal parts must be removed.
- Empty oil and other fluids from auto parts/ mowers.
- **NO television sets**

12. Broken concrete (without rebar), bricks and porcelain

- Sinks, tubs, toilets (all parts removed)

13. Bulky yard waste & clean wood

- Bulky (minimum 2” in diameter) branches, stumps, shrubs, unpainted, untreated wood/plywood.
- **NO particle board**

- #6 Polystyrene plastic
- #1 and #2 plastic bottles
- propane tanks

- pesticides*
- glass: plates, mirrors, windows, bottles, etc.
