



Recycling Collection Event

You can bring items meeting these guidelines:

- **Car, Light Truck and Motorcycle Tires**

Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. Limit 8 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. Additional passenger tires \$1.50 each. Passenger tires on rims \$1.50 each. \$5 for each large truck tire and \$15 for each truck tire on rims. *Cash only.*

- **Uncontaminated Petroleum Based Products**

Oil filters, motor oil, brake fluid, transmission fluid, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, diesel oil and home heating fuel. **Do not mix with antifreeze, gasoline, solvents or other substances.**

- **Uncontaminated Antifreeze**

Do not mix with oil, gasoline, solvents or other substances.

- **Lead Acid Batteries**

Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.

- **Household Batteries**

AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C and D cell batteries only.

- **Appliances & Scrap Metal**

Washers, dryers, microwaves, dishwashers, water heaters, ovens, stoves, lawn mowers and equipment (drain all oil and gas), auto parts, lawn chairs, cast iron sinks & tubs, swing sets, BBQ's, VCR's, iron, steel, aluminum (cans included), brass, copper and other materials accepted. \$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating. **Metals that are insulated, rubber coated, oily, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. No light fixture ballasts.** *Cash only.*

- **Refrigerators/Freezers**

Because of federal regulations concerning ozone depleting refrigerants, \$25 will be charged to remove chemicals from each item brought to the event. \$25 for each household air conditioner and industrial refrigerators. *Cash only.*

- **Textiles & Reusable Household Goods**

Clothing, furniture, and miscellaneous household items that are in usable condition will be accepted. **Must be clean and in good condition for resale by a charity. Items in need of repair, mattresses/box springs and oily rags will not be accepted.**

- **Porcelain Toilets & Sinks**

Toilet seat, base and wax ring must be removed. \$5 each item. *Cash only.*

- **Propane Tanks**

Residential tanks only. \$5 each. *Cash only.*

- **Cardboard**

Please flatten. **No wax coated cardboard.**

- **Cellular Phones**

Batteries, cords, adaptors and chargers.

- **Electronic Equipment**

Computers, printers, mouse, keyboards, fax machines, and scanners. Equipment will be recycled as metal. Computer monitors will be collected for \$10 each. *Cash only.*

- **Clean Scrap Wood**

Scrap wood includes clean wood and pallets. "Clean" means free from any paint, stain, waterproofing or presuring treatments or laminates.

- **Bulky Yard Debris**

Bulky yard debris includes large branches and logs greater than four inches (4") in diameter. No brush, sod, grass clippings, blackberry bushes, leaves, small branches, rocks or stumps. Please lay a tarp under material for ease of removal.

- **Television Sets**

TV sets up to 36" and encased in plastic - **\$20 each.**
TV sets encased in wood, wood console and big screen TV sets - **\$25 each.** Projection TV sets - **\$30 each.**

these *Household* wastes:

- NO construction/demolition debris
- NO grass, leaves, or yard debris
- NO mattresses/furniture
- NO plastic pools, toys, hoses, etc.
- NO window glass
- NO concrete, rock, brick or asphalt
- NO painted or treated wood
- NO garbage
- NO plastic
- NO Styrofoam

these *Hazardous* wastes:

- NO paint
- NO pesticides/herbicides
- NO solvents and thinners
- NO household chemicals
- NO cleaning products
- NO fluorescent lights

Hazardous Wastes can be taken to the Household Hazardous Wastemobile or one of three household hazardous waste collection sites.

The Household Hazardous Wastemobile will visit the Kent Fred Meyer store, 10201 SE 240th St., March 3-5; Federal Way Commons (Sears), 1701 S. 320th St. on March 24-26; and the Renton Fred Meyer store, 365 Renton Center Way, on April 7-9. Volume restrictions apply. Hours are from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
