YOU CAN BRING THE FOLLOWING:

1. Styrofoam loose packing fill--in bags.
2. Plastic plant pots--unbroken, sorted, without soil- 4", 1, 2, & 5 gallon containers.
3. Textiles and Household Goods--items must be reusable. Tax donation receipts available. No furniture. You will have to take back items that are unacceptable.
4. Used Motor Oil and Filters; Antifreeze
5. Batteries--Lead-acid car, truck and marine batteries Household batteries AA,AAA,C,D
6. Tires--\$1 for each, \$2 for each rim, split rim \$5, truck tire \$8, with rim \$20
7. Assorted Electronics--Monitors, Laptops, CPU's \$10, Faxes, Cell Phones, Printers \$5, keyboards and mouse free. TV's \$20, Console TV \$25, Plasma TV's \$75-\$100
No large copiers!
8. Refrigerators and Freezers--\$20 each will be charged for safe removal of CFC's (chlorofluorocarbon coolants)
9. Air Handling Units- \$35
10. Scrap Metal-- hot water tanks, stoves, microwaves, washers, dryers, cast iron sinks and tubs, iron, steel, and auto parts. All materials must have fuel and oil removed. No propane tanks.


