

YOU CAN BRING items meeting these guidelines :

Car, Light Truck & Motorcycle Tires

Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. Limit 8 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. Additional passenger tires \$1.50 each. Passenger tires on rims \$1.50 each. \$5 for each large truck tire and \$15 for each truck tire on rims. **Cash only.**

Untamated Petroleum Based Products

Oil filters, motor oil, brake fluid, transmission fluid, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, diesel oil and home heating fuel. Do not mix with antifreeze, gasoline, solvents or other substances.

Untamated Antifreeze

Do not mix with oil, gasoline, solvents or other substances.

Propane Tanks

Residential tanks only. \$5.00 each. **Cash only.** Small canisters up to 16.5 oz, \$1.50 each.

Household Batteries

AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries only.

Appliances & Scrap Metal

Washers, dryers, microwaves, dishwashers, water heaters, ovens, stoves, BBQ's, lawn mowers and equipment (drain all oil and gas), auto parts, vcr's, swing sets, lawn chairs, iron, steel, aluminum (cans included), cast iron sinks and tubs, brass, copper and other materials accepted. \$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating. **Metals that are insulated, rubber coated, oily, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. No light fixture ballasts. Cash only.**

Porcelain Toilets & Sinks

Toilet seat, base and wax ring must be removed. \$5 each item. **Cash only.**

Lead Acid Batteries

Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.

Refrigerators/Freezers

\$25 for each refrigerator, freezer, household air conditioner and industrial refrigerators. **Cash only.**

Textiles & Reusable Household Goods

Clothing and miscellaneous household items that are in usable condition will be accepted. **Must be clean and in good condition for resale by charity. Items in need of repair, mattresses/box springs and furniture will not be accepted.**

Cellular Phones

Phones, batteries, cords, adaptors and chargers.

Electronic Equipment

Computers, printers, mouse, keyboards, fax machines, and scanners. Equipment will be recycled as metal. Computer monitors will be collected for \$10 each. **Cash only.**

Clean Scrap Wood

Scrap wood includes clean wood and pallets. "Clean" means free from any paint, stain, waterproofing or pressuring treatments or laminates. Please lay a tarp under material for ease of removal.

Bulky Yard Debris

Bulky yard debris includes large branches and logs greater than four inches (4") in diameter. **No brush, sod, grass clippings, blackberry bushes, leaves, small branches, rocks or stumps.** Please lay a tarp under material for ease of removal.

Cardboard

Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.

Television Sets

TV sets with 36 inch or smaller screens and encased in plastic—\$20 charge. TV sets with larger than 36 inch screens, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TV sets—\$25 charge. Projection TV sets—\$30 charge. **Cash only.**

DON'T BRING:

These household wastes:

- **NO** construction/ demolition debris
- **NO** grass, leaves, or small yard debris
- **NO** mattresses/ box springs/furniture
- **NO** garbage
- **NO** window glass/ mirrors
- **NO** plastic pools, toys, hoses, etc.
- **NO** painted, treated wood
- **NO** plastic
- **NO** styrofoam
- **NO** carpeting
- **NO** concrete, rock, brick or asphalt

These hazardous wastes:

- **NO** paint
- **NO** pesticides/ herbicides
- **NO** solvents and thinners
- **NO** household chemicals
- **NO** cleaning products
- **NO** fluorescent lights

Hazardous waste can be taken to the Household Hazardous Wastemobile or one of three household hazardous waste collection sites.
