

Here's What You Can Bring

Mt. Si High School, 8651 Meadowbrook Way S.E. in Snoqualmie
Saturday, September 29th, 2007 9 AM to 3 PM (or until full)

(Numbers match the locations on the layout diagram on the next panel.)



2. Plastic Plant Pots & Peanuts

Unbroken plastic plant pots 4" sq. , 1,3, 5 gallon or larger. Remove soil. Sort pots by size. No tags. Bring clean styrofoam packing peanuts in bags. No styrofoam packing frames.

3. Household Goods/Clothing

Clothing, games, linens, tools, toys, books, and miscellaneous household goods. NO large furniture. Donations to Northwest Center charity. Items must be reusable "as is." No items needing repair. If not accepted, you must take back. Tax receipts available.



4. Oil and Oil Filters/Antifreeze

Please bring used oil in a reusable container like a plastic milk jug or a daintainer and take container home. Do not mix used oil with antifreeze, gasoline, solvents, kitty litter or other contaminants. Keep antifreeze separate.



5. Batteries

Car, truck, motorcycle, and marine lead-acid batteries. Household Alkaline batteries- AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D.

"If in doubt, leave it out"

6. Tires: \$1 each, \$2 if on rim

Passenger, light truck, motorcycle tires 18" or less off the rim \$1 each. Bias, steel belted, or studded are OK. Pay \$2 for pass tire on rim; \$5 for split rim. Truck Tires - \$8, Truck w/ rim - \$20

7. Electronics-Recycle electronics to help keep lead and mercury out of our environment:

TV-\$20; Console TV - \$25
Plasma & Big Screen-\$100
Monitors, small copiers, laptops - \$10.
Computer CPU, Stereo - \$10.
Cell phone, DVD, VCR, Printer - \$5.
Scanner or Fax Machine - \$5.
Keyboards, mice, circuit boards - Free.

Fluorescent light bulbs- .50 ea.!


8. Refrigerated Appliances

There is a \$20 fee for each empty freezer or refrigerator to safely remove chlorofluorocarbon (CFC) refrigerants. \$35 for air handling units and large CFC

9. Scrap Metal and Appliances

Stoves, washers, dryers, microwaves, hot water tanks, auto parts, aluminum chairs, mowers, iron, copper pipe. Remove all fluids. No containers that held hazardous fluids or chemicals. No glass in doors or windows. No fluorescent light fixture ballasts. No tanks or closed containers. No barbed wire. No plastic-cased appliances.

Layout of Collection Stations at Mt. Si High School Front Parking Lot



1. Sign-in
2. Planter Pots/Packing Peanuts
3. Household Goods and Clothing
4. Oil, Oil Filters & Antifreeze
5. Vehicle, lawnmower & household Batteries
6. Tires (\$)
7. TV's , Electronics, Fluorescents (\$)
8. Refrigerators and Freezers (\$)
9. Scrap Metal & Major Appliances

Please pack your load in reverse order according to the setup of collection stations shown on the map above. Load the materials for the higher-numbered stations into the front of your vehicle. This will make it easier to unload the low numbers first. Thanks!

We reserve the right to refuse oversize, commercial, contaminated or unacceptable loads. Please, no dump trucks or flat beds.

Don't Bring:

Construction/Demolition Debris.
Yardwaste or Wood
Garbage or Couches
Please don't take Special Recycling Cleanup Day materials to the Household Hazardous Wastemobile.



Household hazardous waste can be taken to the Household Hazardous Wastemobile or the Factory Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off facility at 13800 SE 132nd St., Bellevue Tues. - Sunday 9-5.

Starting in 2008, the Household Hazardous Wastemobile will no longer accept latex paint. You can dry it out and throw it in the garbage.

You can recycle newspaper, aluminum cans, tin cans, corrugated cardboard, mixed paper, clear/brown/green glass bottles, and some plastics in your curbside recycling program. Remember to recycle Bottles, Jugs, & Tubs- no lids or caps.

To sign up for curbside recycling in Unincorporated King County call your garbage hauler service.


