TIPS FOR PACKING YOUR LOAD:

Load materials with the highest station number first (i.e., if you have items for Station #s 1, 4, 6 and 10, load your vehicle in the following order: 10, 6, 4 and 1). **Remember to secure your load!**

You can bring...

BLUE LANE

Scrap Metal: (Station #1)

Auto parts, broken bikes, lawn chairs, stoves, microwaves, dishwashers, hot water tanks, washers/dryers, BBQs, lawn mowers (drain fluids), iron, steel, aluminum, copper and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. **Maximum length 8ft.** **FREE**

Concrete & Asphalt: (Station #2)

Separate out concrete from asphalt. No Rocks. 1'x1'x1' chunks or smaller. **FREE**

GREEN LANE

Untreated Wood & Lumber: (Station #3)

Includes tree branches, stumps and logs (4 inches in diameter or larger), plywood, pallets, and other untreated and unpainted wood. No peg, particle, or press board. No leaves, grass, small branches, sod, or brush. Please lay a tarp under material for ease of removal. **Maximum length 8ft.** **FREE**

Garden Clippings: (Station #3)

Garden and grass clippings, leaves, and small branches less than 4 inches in diameter. No Sod. **FREE**

Cardboard: (Station #3)

All flattened cardboard. **FREE**

YELLOW LANE

Construction Debris: (Station #4)

Remodeling debris such as decking materials, doors, windows, drywall, roofing materials, flooring, carpet, carpet padding, window glass, insulation materials, all types of ceramic sinks & toilets, fences and fence poles with concrete and bricks. **Maximum length 8ft.** **FREE**

All fees are CASH ONLY!

RED LANE

Tires: (Station #5)

Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted (**19.5 inches and below**).
\$ 1.00 per passenger tire
\$ 2.00 per passenger tire on a rim
\$ 5.00 per truck tire
\$10.00 per truck tire on a rim **\$**

Propane Tanks: (Station #6)

\$5.00 per refillable residential tank
\$1.00 per disposable cylinder
\$2.00 per fire extinguisher
\$3.00 per SCUBA tank
\$1.00 per balloon-type tank **\$**

Refrigerators & Air Conditioners: (Station #7)

\$20.00 per refrigerator
\$20.00 per freezer
\$35.00 per window air conditioner (**household units only**) **\$**

Electronics: (Station #8)

Computers, TVs, VCR & DVD players.
Disposal costs range from \$5.00 to \$25.00 per item.

No small household appliances (e.g., blenders, toasters, deep fryers). **\$**

Motor Oil, Filters & Antifreeze: (Station #9)

Motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, transmission fluid, 2-cycle oil, crankcase oil, kerosene, and home heating fuel. **FREE**
Do not mix antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, or other substances.

Batteries: (Station #10)

Lead Acid: Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries **FREE**
accepted. **Alkaline:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries only.

City of Bothell residents only - I.D. required

- ◆ Residents may bring up to 3 paper grocery bags or 2 copy paper-sized boxes (12"x15"x10") of their residential records (e.g., bank statements, ATM receipts, and old tax records) to this free destruction event at City Hall parking lot.

- ◆ This service is better than simply shredding because it will tear and pulverize your records on the premises making them recyclable material.

Please note: electronic media will not be accepted (e.g., cds, dvds, hard drives).

During your visit, be sure to stop by the City of Bothell Police Department's Identity Theft Information Booth to learn how you and your family can minimize the risk of identity theft.
