

Electronics



Waste Management curbside customers in the city limits recycle most electronics at the curb **FREE**. No appointment necessary for your regular collection day on these dates:

April 28- May 2, May 5-9, May 12-16

FREE at the curb:

Computers, monitors, peripherals, TV's under 21", home copiers and fax machines, microwaves

Not accepted at the curb:

TV's over 21" screens
Console TVs
Kitchen appliances
Wood frame speakers

Accepted at event-CASH ONLY:

Monitors \$10 (CPUs, peripherals, printers, other computer equipment accepted)

TVs \$15 - Small (up to 19")
\$20 - Large (over 19")
\$25 - Consoles
\$30 - Projection (36" and up)

Electronics - VCRs, stereos, cell phones, microwaves and faxes

Allied/Rabanco customers in So. Cove, Lakemont and Greenwood Point bring all electronics to the event.

Refrigerators and Freezers

\$25 each **CASH ONLY**
Empty, residential only.

Batteries

Lead acid car, truck and marine batteries.
All types of household batteries.

Concrete, Rock and Brick



Clothing and Household Goods (good condition ONLY)

NO furniture, mattresses, or burned out BBQs
NO items that are stained, torn or wet.
"If you wouldn't accept it, neither will we".

Compact fluorescent bulbs, tubes



Please, no lighting fixtures or broken tubes. If broken, double bag and take to one of the household hazardous waste facilities.

Porcelain Sinks and Toilets



Remove **seats**, wax rings, metal and plastic hardware

Scrap Wood Waste

Logs, dimensional lumber, pallets, crates, plywood and large branches.

NO painted or stained wood
NO pressure or creosote treated wood
NO laminated wood

Scrap Metal



Includes appliances: stoves, hot water heaters, washers, dryers, mowers (drain oil and gas), BBQs (no propane tanks), auto parts (no excessive grease, please).

No **scavenging** permitted at this recycling event.

Please **DO NOT** bring **HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE** to this recycling event:

Oil-based paint, thinners or solvents
Pesticides
Propane tanks
Hobby, yard or household chemicals
Broken fluorescent bulbs
Motor oil, fuel or antifreeze
Cleaning products
Glues or adhesives

NO latex paint
NO treated, painted or laminated wood
NO window glass
NO styrofoam
NO garbage
NO commercial materials
NO carpet or mattresses
