ITEM	ACCEPTED	NOTES
Scrap Metal	Appliances such as washers and dryers, stoves, hot water heaters, barbecues, cast iron sinks and tubs, lawn mowers, auto parts, swing sets and other metal items. \$5 will be charged for each water heater with insulation. CASH ONLY	Drain all liquids. Metals that are insulated, rubber coated, oily, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint or hazardous material will not be accepted. No light fixtures or ballasts.
Propane Tanks	Residential tanks only. \$5 each. Small canisters up to 16.5 oz, \$1 each. CASH ONLY	
Porcelain Toilets & Sinks	\$5 each item. CASH ONLY	Toilet seat, base & wax rings must be removed.
Refrigerators, Freezers and Air Conditioners	\$25 charge for each unit. CASH ONLY	
Televisions and Computer Monitors	\$10 charge for monitors, \$20 for TVs with screens 36" or smaller, \$25 for consoles and oversized televisions. \$30 for projection televisions. CASH ONLY	
Electronics	Computer CPUs, keyboards, mice, printers, fax machines, scanners, cell phones and CD/DVD players.	
Petroleum-Based Products	Motor oil, oil filters, gasoline, diesel fuel, 2-cycle mix, transmission fluid, brake fluid, antifreeze, kerosene, and home heating fuel.	No unmarked or mixed liquids. Do not mix any of the liquids together.
Tires—Car, Light Truck & Motorcycle	Biased, steel-belted & studded tires accepted. Limit of 8 passenger tires (18" and below)—Free. Passenger tires on rims—\$1.50 each. \$5 for each large truck tire, \$15 if on rims. CASH ONLY	
Reusable Household Goods	Small appliances in working condition, reusable clothing, shoes, pots, pans, bedding, books and toys. All items must be clean and in good condition for resale by a charity.	No broken, torn, stained or wet items. No furniture, carpet or mattresses.
Shredding	Limit of 3 file-size boxes per vehicle—no exceptions.	Service donated by Shred-It, located in Kent.
Concrete, Asphalt, Rock & Brick	Place on tarp for easy removal. Rocks and smaller materials must be in boxes or buckets.	Remove plastic, metal and wood. Residential material only.
Cardboard	Please flatten boxes.	No wax-coated cardboard.
Batteries	Car, truck, marine and motorcycle batteries. Alkaline Batteries AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, & D cell batteries only.	

Please do NOT bring... NO oil-based paints, pesticides, household chemicals, solvents or thinners, or fluorescent lights; Latex paint is no longer accepted—please dry out and place in trash. For information on disposal of hazardous waste, call 206-296-4692. NO grass, leaves or yard waste; NO bulky or scrap wood; NO plastic or Styrofoam; NO carpeting or construction or demolition debris; NO window glass; For information on where to dispose of these, call 253-856-5549.

PLEASE NOTE: No vehicles may enter after 3 p.m. No flatbeds or dump trucks allowed. We reserve the right to refuse oversized, commercial, contaminated, excessive or unacceptable loads.
