


Location Map

YOU CAN BRING:

Batteries:

Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries.
AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries.

Bulky Wood:

Tree branches (minimum 6 inches in diameter), logs, clean wood, plywood, pallets, and other untreated and unpainted wood.

NO particle or press board. No leaves, grass, small branches, sod, brush, painted, or stained wood. Please lay a tarp under material to ease removal.

Cardboard:

Please flatten. No wax-coated cardboard.

Computer Monitors: **\$10 charge (cash only)**

Electronic equipment is collected at the curb for Kirkland single-family residents!

Electronic Equipment:

Computers, printers, mice, key boards, fax machines, scanners, and cell phones.

Fluorescent Light Collection:

Fluorescent tubes and bulbs and incandescent bulbs.
Limit 10 bulbs per participant.

NO light fixture ballasts or broken lights.

Household Goods and Clothing:

Clothing and assorted household items in saleable condition.

NO mattresses. Furniture and other items in need of repair not accepted.

Motor Oil, Filters, and Antifreeze:

Uncontaminated motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, brake fluid, transmission fluid, 2-cycle oil, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, and home heating fuel.

DO NOT mix oils, antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, or other substances.

Porcelain Toilets and Sinks: **\$5 charge (cash only)**

Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed.

Propane Tanks:

Residential tanks only. **\$5 charge (cash only)**

Television Sets:

Sets less than 36 inch and encased in plastic:

\$20 charge (cash only)

Set greater than 36 inch, wood console, big screen sets:

\$25 charge (cash only)

Projection sets: **\$30 charge (cash only)**

Tires:

Bias ply, steel-belted, and studded tires. Limit 4 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge.

NO tires on rims, large truck tires, or oversized tires.

DO NOT BRING:

HOUSEHOLD WASTE

Scrap metal or appliances
Construction/demolition debris
Garbage
Mattresses/furniture
Plastic toys, hoses, etc
Window glass
Painted wood

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Paint
Pesticides/herbicides
Solvents or thinners
Household chemicals
Cleaning products

Starts January 1, 2008



Dry out your latex paint!

King County's Local Hazardous Waste Management Program Facilities (Factoria and the Wastemobile) will **NOT** accept latex paint after January 1st, 2008.

To harden paint,

- 1) Mix latex paint with an equal amount of kitty litter or paint hardener
- 2) Stir in completely
- 3) Let the paint dry.
Once dry, put the can in your garbage container with the lid off.
