Items Must Meet the Following Guidelines.....



You Can Bring...

•**TIRES:** Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. Limit 6 passenger tires per participant (18 inches and below) free of charge. **\$1.50 charge for each tire on a rim. \$5 charged for each large truck tire and \$15 charged for each truck tire on rim (cash only). No oversized tires accepted.**

•**MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, & ANTIFREEZE:** Motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, brake fluid, transmission fluid, 2-cycle oil, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, and home heating fuel. Do not mix with antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, or other substances. Empty used oil or antifreeze containers will not be accepted.

•**LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.

•**ALKALINE BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries only.

•**HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING:** Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. Furniture will not be accepted. Mattresses will not be accepted. Items in need of repair will not be accepted.

•**PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed. **\$5 charge (cash only).**

•**PROPANE TANKS:** Residential tanks only. **\$5 charge (cash only).**

•**CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.

•**APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Auto parts, engines and gas lawnmowers (drained of oil and gasoline), metal lawn chairs, stoves, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. **\$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating (cash only).** Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts and sealed drums will not be accepted.

•**REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** **\$25 will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer.** \$25 will be charged for each household air conditioner **(cash only).**

•**ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT:** Computers, printers, mouse, keyboards, fax machines, cellular phones, and scanners. Equipment will be recycled as metal. **Computer monitors will be collected for \$10 each (cash only).**

•**TELEVISION SETS:** TV sets with 36 inch or smaller screens and encased in plastic - **\$20 charge (cash only).** TV sets with larger than 36 inch screens, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TV sets - **\$25 charge (cash only).** **Projection TV sets - \$30 charge (cash only).**

Regrets. We are not able to collect organic debris and scrap wood at this event.




These household wastes:

No scrap wood/yard debris
No construction/demolition debris
No garbage
No mattresses/furniture
No plastic toys, hoses, etc.
No window glass

These hazardous wastes:

No paint
No pesticides/herbicides
No solvents and thinners
No household chemicals
No cleaning products
No fluorescent lights




New Rules For Latex Paint

Latex paint is no longer considered hazardous waste and the household hazardous waste facilities in King County (the Wastemobile and Factoria) no longer accept it. Residents who cannot use up latex paint, please dry it out and put it in the garbage with the lid off. Visit the King County website www.metrokc.gov/dnrp/swd for more information on how to dry out latex paint. Residents can also drop-off other household hazardous waste at the Seattle household hazardous waste sites but not latex paint.

Household hazardous wastes can be taken to the Household Hazardous Waste Wastemobile or household hazardous waste collection sites in Seattle and Bellevue (Factoria). The Factoria Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Site is located at 13800 SE 32nd Street, Bellevue. The site is open 9 am – 5 pm, Tuesday through Sunday (except holidays). There is a 30 gallon limit per customer per day and customers will not get their containers back. No containers can be over five gallons in size.
