
****Location: Tukwila Village Site – Corner of South 144 St**
and 41st Ave S in Tukwila (One block West of Foster High School)**



Date: May 17, 2008 9am to 3pm

Items Must Meet the Following Guidelines

- **CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.
- **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential tanks only. **\$5 charge (cash only).**
- **ALKALINE BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries only.
- **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.
- **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed. **\$5 charge (cash only).**
- **MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, & ANTIFREEZE:** Motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, brake fluid, transmission fluid, 2-cycle oil, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, and home heating fuel. Do not mix with antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, or other substances.
- **HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING:** Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. Mattresses will not be accepted. Furniture will not be accepted. Items in need of repair will not be accepted.
- **REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** **\$25 will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer.** \$25 will be charged for each household air conditioner **(cash only).**
- **ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT:** Computers, printers, mouse, keyboards, fax machines, copiers, scanners, and cellular phones. Equipment will be recycled as metal. **Computer monitors will be collected for a \$10 charge (cash only).**
- **TELEVISION SETS:** TV sets with 36 inch or smaller screens and encased in plastic - **\$20 charge (cash only).** TV sets with larger than 36 inch screens, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TV sets - **\$25 charge (cash only).** **Projection TV sets - \$30 charge (cash only).**
- **BULKY WOOD:** Includes tree branches (minimum 6 inches in diameter), logs, clean wood, plywood, pallets, and other untreated and unpainted wood. **No leaves, grass, small branches, sod, brush, painted, or stained wood. No peg board, particle or press board. Please lay a tarp under material for ease of removal.**
- **TIRES:** Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. **Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge.** **\$1.50 charge for each tire on a rim. \$5 charged for each large truck tire and \$15 charged for each truck tire on rim (cash only).** **No oversized tires accepted.**
- **APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Auto parts, appliances, microwaves, stoves, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. **\$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating (cash only).** Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts and sealed drums will not be accepted.



We reserve the right to refuse oversized, commercial, contaminated, excessive, or unacceptable loads.

These household wastes:

No construction/demolition debris
No garbage
No mattresses/furniture
No plastic toys, hoses, etc.
No window glass

These household hazardous wastes:

No paint
No pesticides/herbicides
No household chemicals
No cleaning products
No fluorescent lights

New Rules For Latex Paint


Latex paint is no longer considered hazardous waste and the household hazardous waste facilities in King County (the Wastemobile and Factoria) no longer accept it. Residents who cannot use up latex paint, please dry it out and put it in the garbage with the lid off. Visit the King County website www.metrokc.gov/dnpr/swd for more information on how to dry out latex paint. Residents can also drop-off other household hazardous waste at the Seattle household hazardous waste sites but not latex paint.

Household hazardous wastes can be taken to the Household Hazardous Wastemobile or one of three household hazardous waste collection sites. **Tukwila** residents may use the South Seattle Household Hazardous Waste Facility – 8105 5th Avenue South, Seattle. Open 10 am – 4 pm, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday (except major holidays). Volume restrictions apply.




