


Woodinville Park & Ride NE 179th and 140th NE

KEEP IN MIND that the higher the station number for a type of material, the earlier that material should be loaded into your vehicle.

Items must meet the subsequent guidelines:

All fees are **CASH ONLY!**



Service Provider shall have no obligation to collect any hazardous or other materials that do not conform to the specific descriptions below.

STATION 1 - TIRES: Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. \$1.00 charge for each passenger tire (19.5" and below). \$2.50 charge for each tire on a rim. \$5 charge for each large semi-truck tire and \$15 charge for each semi-truck tire on rim.

STATION 2 - OIL, FILTERS & ANTIFREEZE: Motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, transmission fluid, 2-cycle oil, crankcase oil, kerosene, and home heating fuel. **Do not mix with antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, or other substances.**

STATION 3 - BATTERIES: **Lead Acid:** car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted. **Alkaline:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries only.

STATION 4 - HOUSEHOLD GOODS: Gently used clothing and textiles, and small furniture in good condition only. **Mattresses not accepted.** Items in need of repair not accepted.

STATION 5 - REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS & AIR CONDITIONERS: \$20 charge for each refrigerator and freezer. \$35 charge for each window air conditioner (household units only).

STATION 6 - ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT: TVs over 36" (\$45); Console TVs (\$25 charge); televisions (\$20 charge); computer monitors (\$8 charge); copiers, laptops (\$10 charge); computer CPUs, stereos (\$7 charge); DVDs, VCRs, printers, scanners, fax machines, power supplies (\$5 charge); telephones, cell phones (\$3 charge); keyboards (\$2 charge) and mice (no charge). **No commercial units or small household appliances (e.g., blenders, toasters, etc.)**

STATION 7 - PROPANE TANKS: Refillable residential tanks, disposable tanks, fire extinguishers, SCUBA tanks, and balloon-type tanks.

STATION 8 - APPLIANCES & SCRAP METAL: Auto parts, broken bikes, lawn chairs, stoves, microwaves, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted.

STATION 9 - CARDBOARD: Please flatten. **No wax coated cardboard.**

STATION 10 - CLEAN WOOD: Includes clean wood, plywood, pallets, and other untreated and unpainted wood. **No peg, particle, or press board.**

STATION 11 - BULKY WOOD: Includes tree branches (6" in diameter and greater) and logs. **No leaves, grass, small branches, sod, or brush.** For easy removal, please lay tarp under material.

STATION 12 - PORCELAIN SINKS & TOILETS: Please remove toilet seats, hardware and base wax rings.

PLEASE NOTE: Set-up, stationing and material collection may be different than past recycling events in this location. Please refer to this flyer for materials that **will be** accepted.

DON'T BRING!



THESE HOUSEHOLD WASTES:

No construction/demolition debris
No yard waste or treated wood
No plastic toys, hoses, etc.
No mattresses & large furniture
No window glass, No garbage

THESE HAZARDOUS WASTES:

No pesticides/herbicides
No paints*, solvents & thinners
No household chemicals & cleaning products
No fluorescent lights & light fixture ballasts*

*Latex paint is no longer hazardous waste. King County residents need to dispose of it by drying it out and placing it in the garbage with the lid off.

*Ballasts containing polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) should be double bagged and taken to the Wastemobile or a household hazardous waste facility. Those stamped "No PCBs" can be taken to a transfer station.
