


Items Must Meet the Following Guidelines.....



You Can Bring...

- **TIRES:** Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. **Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$1.50 charge for each tire on a rim. \$5 charged for each large truck tire and \$15 charged for each truck tire on rim (cash only). No oversized tires accepted.**
- **MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, & ANTIFREEZE:** Motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, brake fluid, transmission fluid, 2-cycle oil, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, and home heating fuel. Do not mix antifreeze with solvents, gasoline, or other substances.



- **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.
- **ALKALINE BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries only.
- **CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.
- **HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING:** Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. Mattresses and furniture will not be collected. Items in need of repair will not be accepted.
- **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Remove toilet seats, hardware, and wax rings. **\$5 charge (cash only).**
- **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential tanks only. **\$5 charge (cash only).**
- **BULKY WOOD:** Logs, large tree branches (minimum 6 inches in diameter), clean wood, plywood, pallets, and other untreated and unpainted wood. **No leaves, grass, small branches, or sod. No peg board, particle, or press board. Please lay a tarp under material for ease of removal.**
- **APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Auto parts, lawn chairs, stoves, microwaves, barbecues, engines and gas lawnmowers (drained of oil and gasoline), iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. **\$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating (cash only).** Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts and sealed drums will not be accepted.
- **REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS/HOUSEHOLD AIR CONDITIONERS:** **\$25 charge for each refrigerator, freezer, or household air conditioner (cash only).**
- **PAINT:** Oil based paint, stains, solvents, and thinners only. **No latex paint or spray paint. Limit of ten containers of paint per participant. Empty used paint containers will be returned to residents.**
- **ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, and cellular phones. Computers, printers, mouse, keyboards, fax machines, scanners, and cellular phones. **Computer monitors will be collected for a \$10 charge (cash only). However, you can recycle your computer monitor for free - see the E-Cycle box for more information.**
- **TELEVISION SETS:** TV sets with 36 inch or smaller screens and encased in plastic - **\$20 charge (cash only).** TV sets with larger than 36 inch screens, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TV sets - **\$25 charge (cash only).** Projection TV sets - **\$30 charge (cash only).** **However, you can recycle your TV set for free - see the E-Cycle box for more information.**

- These household wastes:**
- No construction/demolition debris
 - No garbage
 - No mattresses/furniture
 - No plastic toys, hoses, etc.
 - No window glass
- These hazardous wastes:**
- No pesticides/herbicides
 - No household chemicals
 - No cleaning products
 - No fluorescent lights

Household hazardous wastes (but not latex paint) can be taken to the Household Hazardous Wastemobile at the Auburn Supermall on the 1st and 3rd full (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) weekends of each month from 10 am to 5 pm. The Wastemobile will be located in Northwest corner of the mall off of SuperMall Way. E-Cycle Washington is Here!

Washington now has a FREE recycling program called "E-Cycle Washington" for computers, computers monitors, laptops, and televisions. Call 1-800-RECYCLE or visit 1800recycle.wa.gov to find authorized E-Cycle Washington collection locations. You may drop off computers, computers monitors, laptops, and televisions at no charge at the following E-Cycle Washington location: Commercial Metal Recycling (117 Frontage Rd No., Bldg. C, Pacific, WA 98047, 253-833-4146) and the Goodwill Auburn Store (1519 Auburn Way S, Auburn, WA 98002, 253-573-1333). Please note - drop off locations and charges may change and quantities accepted may be limited. Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at the Pacific Recycling Collection Event.

Rain Barrel Sale

To help residents use water more efficiently, the City of Pacific is offering rain barrels. These high-quality rain barrels are being made available to City residents at a reduced cost. The rain barrels normally retail for about \$120, but Pacific residents will pay only \$20. Quantities are very limited. Residents are limited to one rain barrel per household. Holds up to 55 gallons of rainwater.


