Accepted Materials

Cardboard...Non-waxed or coated, flattened.

CDs, Floppy Disks, Video Tapes

Cellular Phones...Phones, batteries, chargers, adapters.

Computers & Components... Computers, monitors (\$10 cash only)*, keyboards, printers, mice.

Confidential Materials...Shredding and recycling service for confidential paper materials.

Limit of 5 file size boxes per business.

Plastics... Grocery bags, stretch wrap, film, bubble wrap, shrink wrap, garment bags.

Scrap Metal... Chairs, desks, file cabinets, telephones, fax machines, typewriters, adding machines, copiers, other ferrous and non-ferrous metals.

Refrigerators and Freezers... \$25 will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer. \$25 will be charged for each household air conditioner (cash only).

Televisions...Encased in plastic and less than 36"-\$20 each (cash only). TV's encased in wood, wood console and big screen-\$25 each (cash only). Projection TV's-\$30 each (cash only).*


