Scrap Lumber	Clean, unpainted and untreated wood, plywood, pallets, dimensional lumber and crates.	NO dirty, painted, pressure treated, stained or laminated wood or particle board. Bulky Brush and Branches	Stumps, logs and tree branches that are at least 3 inches in diameter and less than 4 feet long (those items that don't normally fit in your yard debris cart).	NO yard debris such as grass clippings, sod, weeds, small twigs or garden waste. NO commercial loads.	NO assistance is available to unload stumps from vehicles. 
