## Only the Following Items Will be Accepted.....



**You Can Bring...**

- **TIRES:** Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. **\$1.50 charge for each tire on a rim. \$5 charged for each large truck tire and \$15 charged for each truck tire on rim (cash only). No oversized tires accepted.**
- **MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, & ANTIFREEZE:** Motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, brake fluid, transmission fluid, 2-cycle oil, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, and home heating fuel. Do not mix with antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, or other substances. Empty oil or antifreeze containers will not be accepted.



- **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.
- **ALKALINE BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries only.
- **HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING:** Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. Mattresses will not be accepted. Furniture and items in need of repair will not be accepted.
- **CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.
- **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential five gallon tanks only. **\$5 charge (cash only).**
- **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed. **\$5 charge (cash only).**
- **ELECTRONIC/COMPUTER EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, and cellular phones. Computers and computer monitors (**no charge**), mouse, and keyboards.
- **TELEVISION SETS:** TV sets encased in plastic, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TVs accepted (**no charge**).
- **REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** **\$25 will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer.** \$25 will be charged for each household air conditioner (**cash only**).
- **APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Auto parts, engines and gas lawnmowers (drained of oil and gasoline), metal lawn chairs, stoves, microwaves, barbecues, steel, aluminum, brass, copper and other ferrous and non-ferrous metals. **\$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating (cash only).** Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain chemicals **gas, oil, paint,** or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts and sealed drums will not be accepted.

**These household wastes:**  
**No paint of any kind**

- No scrap wood/bulky wood
- No construction/demolition debris
- No garbage
- No mattresses/furniture
- No plastic toys, hoses, etc.
- No window glass

**These hazardous wastes:**

- No oil based paint
- No pesticides/herbicides
- No solvents and thinners
- No household chemicals
- No cleaning products
- No fluorescent lights

**Household hazardous wastes** can be taken to the Household Hazardous Wastemobile, the Auburn SuperMall Wastemobile, and the hazardous waste collection site in Factoria. The Factoria site is located at 13800 SE 32<sup>nd</sup> Street, Bellevue. The site is open 8 am - 4 pm Tuesday - Friday and 9 am - 5 pm Saturday and Sunday (except holidays). There is a 50 gallon limit and a gasoline limit of 30 gallons per customer per day and customers will not get their containers back. No containers can be over five gallons in size. Separate motor (crankcase) oil from all other fluids. Pure crankcase oil containers will be returned.

Recycling (970 7th Ave NW Issaquah, WA 98027, 425-274-4020), and Goodwill Bellevue Store (14515 NE 20th St, Bellevue, WA, 98007, 425-649-2080). Please note - drop off locations and conditions may change. Quantities accepted maybe limited - call first. Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at City Recycling Collection Events.

## Compost Bin Sale

Start backyard composting with a **compost bin** to save resources and money. Composting is a natural process that turns yard waste into rich soil. Yard waste—grass, leaves, old flowers—contain mostly water. Once the material decomposes, rich soil is all that's left. The rain barrels normally retail for about \$80, but residents will pay only \$25. Quantities are limited.
