

Only the Following Items Will be Accepted:

Television Sets

TV sets with 36 inch or smaller screens and encased in plastic - \$20 charge (cash only). TV sets with larger than 36 inch screens, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TV sets - \$25 charge (cash only). Projection TV sets - \$30 charge (cash only). **However, you can recycle your TV set for free - see the E-Cycle box for more information.**

Computer Monitors

A \$10 (cash only) fee will be charged for each monitor. **However, you can recycle your computer monitor for free - see the E-Cycle box for more information.**



Note that TV sets and computer monitors (21 inches and under) are collected at curbside for free in Bellevue for single-family residents.

Electronic Equipment

DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, cellular phones and computer peripherals such as keyboards and mice.

Appliances & Scrap Metal

Stoves, microwaves, washers, dryers, other appliances, metal push and gas lawnmowers (drained of oil and gasoline), auto parts, metal lawn chairs, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper and other ferrous and non-ferrous metals free of charge. Electric lawnmowers are accepted as long as the batteries are removed. A \$25 (cash only) fee will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer brought to the event. A \$5 (cash only) fee will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating. No containers that previously or currently contain gas, oil, chemicals or paint will be accepted.

Auto Batteries

Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle lead acid type batteries only.

Household Batteries

Please hold on to these. Due to high collection costs, we will only be collecting these batteries at the fall collection event in 2011. Thanks for your patience!

Clean Scrap Wood

Milled lumber, plywood, and pallets. These wood products must be untreated and unpainted. Please do NOT bring furniture, yard waste, stumps, branches, construction or demolition material, as it will NOT be accepted.

Porcelain Toilets and Sinks

Toilets and sinks will be accepted for a \$10 (cash only) fee. Toilet seats, hardware and base wax rings must be removed.



Textiles and Reusable Household Goods

Clothing and miscellaneous household items in usable condition are accepted. Tax receipts available to donors. NO items in need of repair, carpet, area rugs, or furniture.

Propane Tanks

Residential tanks will be accepted for a \$5 (cash only) fee.

Cardboard

Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.

Number Six Plastics

Styrofoam hot beverage cups, fast food clam-shell containers, egg cartons, and meat trays; polystyrene clear rigid food containers such as cake domes and hinged salad containers. Look for a #6 on the bottom. No Styrofoam material such as packing peanuts or frames will be accepted. Some local retailers will accept packing peanuts. Please call 425-452-6932 for a referral.

Mattresses

This is a pilot project. Mattresses, box springs and futons, any size. **Fee:** \$10 per mattress, box spring, or futon. Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.

NEW - TIRES

Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$1.50 charge for each tire on a rim. \$5 charged for each large truck tire and \$15 charged for each truck tire on rim (cash only). No oversized tires accepted.

NO Plastic Plant Containers

The market for this material is no longer viable so it will not be collected. Please check with your local nursery to see if you can return this material for reuse.



Washington has a FREE recycling program called **E-Cycle Washington** for computers, computer monitors, laptops, and televisions. Visit 1800recycle.wa.gov to find authorized E-Cycle Washington collection locations. You may drop off computers, computer monitors, laptops, and televisions at no charge at the following E-Cycle Washington locations: **Goodwill Bellevue Store (14515 NE 20th St, Bellevue, WA, 98007, 425-649-2080), PC Recycle (13107 NE 20th, Suite-2, Bellevue, WA, 98005, 425-881-4444), and George Electronix (15015 Main St #109, Bellevue, WA, 98007, 425-643-4471).** Please note - drop off locations and conditions may change. Quantities accepted are limited. **Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at the City Recycling Collection Day.**

Rules For Latex Paint

Latex paint is no longer considered hazardous waste and the household hazardous waste facilities in Seattle and King County no longer accept it. Residents who cannot use latex paint should dry it out with kitty litter and put it in the garbage with the lid off. Visit the King County website www.kingcounty.gov/dnrp/swd for more information on how to dry out latex paint.

Hazardous Waste:

The Factoria Hazardous Waste Shed and the Household Hazardous Wastemobile will accept :

- Antifreeze
- Fluorescent Lights - limit 10
- Household Chemicals
- Motor Oil/Filters
- Solvents
- Pesticides/Herbicides
- Oil Based Paint

The Factoria Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Service is open Tuesday - Friday from 8 am to 4 pm and Saturday - Sunday from 9 am to 5 pm. There is a 50 gallon limit and a gasoline limit of 30 gallons per customer per day. Customers will not get their containers back. No containers can be over five gallons in size. Separate motor (crankcase) oil from all other fluids. Pure crankcase oil containers will be returned.

Please note lines are longer on recycling event days. **PLAN TO VISIT ANOTHER DAY.**
