1st	SCRAP METAL, APPLIANCES	Barbecues, microwaves, cast iron sinks and tubs, lawnmowers, stoves, hot water heaters, washers & dryers.	No cars, trailers, dishwashers or greasy metal. Lawnmowers – remove gas & oil.	Please drain all liquids and remove any plastic or rubber from metal.
2nd	REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS, AIR CONDITIONERS	Household refrigerators and freezers Household air conditioners,	No commercial appliances or automobile air conditioning units.	
3rd	FLUORESCENT BULBS/TUBES	Fluorescent bulbs or tubes \$0.50/each	Limit of ten bulbs and tubes. No lighting fixtures or broken tubes.	Double bag & take broken tubes to Wastemobile.
4th	ELECTRONICS	Computers, monitors, laptops, keyboards, scanners, printers, fax machines, power supplies.	Call 1-800 RECYCLE or visit: www.1800recycle.wa.org No mice accepted.	
5th	ALL OTHER ELECTRONICS	Stereos, TV's, DVD players, VCR's, phones, anything with a plug.	No commercial equipment. No large copiers. This is a residential event.	
6th	PETROLEUM PRODUCTS	Motor oil, gasoline, diesel fuel, 2-cycle mix, transmission & brake fluid, kerosene, antifreeze and oil filters.	No unmarked or mixed liquids. Containers must be properly sealed.	Do not mix liquids together.
7th	TIRES	On or off rim light truck, car and motorcycle tires. \$1.25 ea. \$2.50 on rim, \$5 w/split rim, \$7.50 truck tires, \$18 truck tires on rim.	No tires with an inner circle diameter greater than 18.” Biased, steel-belted & studded tires accepted.	This is a residential event. <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>
8th	BATTERIES	Car, truck, marine lead acid batteries.	Household alkaline batteries can now be placed in personal trash containers at home.	Pre-sort large quantities.
Load last	CLOTHING & HOUSEHOLD ITEMS	Reusable items that work: clothing, shoes, bedding, pots, books, small appliances, & toys.	No broken, torn, stained, wet items. No furniture, carpet or mattresses.
