
These household wastes:

- No paint of any kind
- No scrap metal/appliances
- No construction/demolition debris
- No garbage
- No mattresses/furniture
- No plastic toys, hoses, etc.
- No window glass

These hazardous wastes:

- No oil based paint
- No pesticides/herbicides
- No solvents and thinners
- No household chemicals
- No cleaning products
- No fluorescent lights

Only the Following Items Will be Accepted.....



You Can Bring...

- **TIRES:** Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. **\$1.50 charge for each tire on a rim. \$5 charged for each large truck tire and \$15 charged for each truck tire on rim (cash only). No oversized tires accepted.**
- **MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, & ANTIFREEZE:** Motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, brake fluid, transmission fluid, 2-cycle oil, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, and home heating fuel. Do not mix with antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, or other substances. Empty oil or antifreeze containers will not be accepted.



- **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.
- **ALKALINE BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries only.
- **HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING:** Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. Mattresses will not be accepted. Furniture and items in need of repair will not be accepted.
- **CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.
- **BULKY WOOD:** Includes tree branches (minimum 6 inches in diameter), logs, clean wood, plywood, pallets, and other untreated and unpainted wood. **No leaves, grass, branches, sod, brush, painted, or stained wood. Please lay a tarp under material for ease of removal.**
- **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential five gallon tanks only. **\$5 charge (cash only).**
- **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed. **\$10 charge (cash only).**
- **ELECTRONIC/COMPUTER EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, and cellular phones. Computers and computer monitors (**no charge**), mouse, and keyboards.
- **TELEVISION SETS:** TV sets encased in plastic, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TVs accepted (**no charge**).



Washington has a FREE recycling program called "E-Cycle Washington" for computers, computer monitors, laptops, and televisions. Visit 1800recycle.wa.gov to find authorized E-Cycle Washington collection locations. You may drop off computers, computer monitors, laptops, and televisions for free at the following E-Cycle Washington locations: 1 Green Planet, 1780 NW Maple St, Issaquah, WA 98027, 425-996-3513), AtWork! Recycling (970 7th Ave NW Issaquah, WA 98027, 425-274-4020), and Goodwill Bellevue Store (14515 NE 20th St, Bellevue, WA, 98007, 425-649-2080). Please note - drop off locations and conditions may change. Quantities accepted maybe limited - call first. Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at City Recycling Collection Events.

Household hazardous wastes can be taken to the Auburn Supermall and the regular roving Wastemobile or the household hazardous waste collection sites in **Bellevue (Factoria)** and Seattle. **The Wastemobile will visit Sammamish from August 12-14, 2011. Location: Eastlake High School-400 228th Ave NE. Hours are 10 am to 5 pm. There is a 50 gallon limit and a gasoline limit of 30 gallons per customer per day. No containers can be over five gallons in size.**

Rain Barrel, Compost, and Worm Bin Sale

To encourage the use of recycled content material and more efficient use of water, the City is offering recycled plastic **rain barrels** at a huge discount. In addition, start backyard composting with a **compost bin** to save resources and money. Composting is a natural process that turns yard waste into rich soil. Yard waste contains mostly water. Once the material decomposes, rich soil is all that's left.


