<b>Appliances &amp; Scrap Metal</b>	Washers, dryers, microwaves, ovens, stoves, water heaters, engines, BBQs, lawn mowers, metal lawn chairs, swing sets, cast iron sinks and tubs, auto parts, iron, steel, aluminum (cans included), brass, copper & other ferrous and non-ferrous metals. Please drain all liquids from materials.	<b>NO</b> metals that are insulated, rubber coated, oily, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials. <b>NO</b> light fixture ballasts. <b>NO</b> sealed drums.
<b>Refrigerators, Freezers &amp; Air Conditioners</b>	Refrigerators, freezers, and portable household air conditioners.	<b>NO</b> industrial fridges and freezers.
<b>Toilets &amp; Sinks</b>	Toilet seat, base, and wax ring must be removed.	
<b>Electronics</b>	Cell phones, printers, keyboards, fax machines, scanners, VCRs, CD/DVD players and stereos. Take computers & TVs to the Kent Goodwill Store, 25814 102nd Pl. SE any day at no charge. More info at 253.573.1333	<b>NO</b> computer monitors, laptop computers, TVs. Take these to Kent Goodwill Stores. Any day, no charge.
<b>Cardboard</b>	Please flatten.	<b>NO</b> wax-coated cardboard.
<b>Alkaline Batteries</b>	AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries only.	<b>NO</b> rechargeable batteries/ <b>NO</b> Ni-cads
<b>Lead Acid Batteries</b>	Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.	
<b>Petroleum-Based Products</b>	Motor oil, brake fluid, transmission fluid, steering fluid, crankcase oil, antifreeze, kerosene, diesel oil and home heating fuel and oil filters. Do not mix any liquids together. Please ensure containers are clearly labeled with contents and tightly sealed.	<b>NO</b> mixed liquids.
<b>Propane Tanks</b>	Residential tanks only.	
<b>Tires</b>	Light truck, car and motorcycle tires. Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. Limit 8 passenger tires per vehicle (18 inches and below) free of charge.	
<b>Bulky Yard Debris</b>	Logs and large branches greater than four inches in diameter.	<b>NO</b> brush, sod, grass clippings, blackberry bushes, leaves, small branches, rocks or stumps.
<b>Scrap Wood</b>	Clean wood and pallets. Place on tarp for easy removal. No need to remove nails.	<b>NO</b> painted, stained, treated or laminated wood or particle board.
<b>Reusable Household Goods</b>	Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. All items must be clean and in good enough condition for resale by a charitable organization.	<b>NO</b> broken, torn, stained, damaged or wet items. <b>NO</b> furniture.
<b>Styrofoam and Packing Peanuts</b>	White styrofoam blocks. Expanded polystyrene styrofoam only. Packing peanuts (any color). Look for the #6 or EPS inside the recycling symbol. Peanuts need to be in box or bag. Clean and dry materials only.	<b>NO</b> urethane foam cushions, hot tub covers, expanded polypropylene or foam insulation.

**NO** flatbeds or dump trucks allowed. Vendors reserve the right to refuse oversized, commercial, contaminated, excessive or unacceptable loads.

**DON'T BRING THESE HOUSEHOLD WASTES:**

- **NO** construction/demolition debris
- **NO** concrete, rock, brick or asphalt
- **NO** grass, leaves, or small yard debris
- **NO** garbage
- **NO** window glass/mirrors
- **NO** latex paint (see note below)
- **NO** plastic pools, toys, hoses, etc.
- **NO** painted/treated wood
- **NO** carpeting

Latex paint may be dried out by leaving the lid off, or by adding equal amounts of cat litter or paint hardener, then placed in the garbage once dry. Share larger amounts with friends or donate to a local theater group. Donate full cans to Habitat for Humanity: **206.292.5240**

**DON'T BRING THESE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTES:**

- **NO** oil-based paint
- **NO** solvents and thinners
- **NO** cleaning products
- **NO** pesticides/herbicides
- **NO** household chemicals
- **NO** fluorescent lights
